The Nation wide Lockdown following the COVID -19 Pandemic has led to a burst of activity with Online Education. The COVID- 19 has resulted in Schools shut all across the world. As a result, Education has changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-Learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms.

To create an awareness on e- Learning, the teachers were engaged in the Month of May 2020. Online quiz programme was conducted for the teaching and non teaching staff. 



The parents felt so happy in attending such a useful program.






STO EXAM- STATE LEVEL OFFICIAL EXAM
